

Care Instructions for Camira Transport Fabrics

Seats should be dry vacuumed at least every month.

'In Situ' wet vacuuming, using a reputable wool safe shampoo, should take place at least every 6 months.

Localised stains should be removed as quickly as possible.

Seat covers may be removed and wet washed, having first been turned inside out. Note – wet washing could result in initial shrinkage of between 2 – 4 % in each direction.
