

## Care Instructions for Regentex® Canvas

### Weathering or Breaking In

Due to stitching holes during manufacture of final products, we recommend that you thoroughly saturate the item and allow to dry naturally before use. This will allow the cotton content in the fabric and the thread to swell and increase the water resistance.

In the case of horse covers it is best to do this whilst the cover is on the horse, as this will help to 'shape' the cover to the contours of the horse.

### General Care

- Brush off dry dirt
- Hose down with cool water
- Use a soft bristled brush with clean water to treat soiled areas
- Rinse with cool water
- Leave extended to dry in warm circulating air
- Re-use once completely dry
- Re-proof when necessary

### Do Not

- Hot wash, dry clean or tumble dry
- Use high pressure hose which may damage the proofing
- Use biological detergents which may adversely affect the proofing characteristics
- Store when wet

### Reproofing

We recommend reproofing of Regentex® canvas products after prolonged exposure to the elements. Bradmill Outdoor Fabrics' Brellaproof® is recommended for this purpose. It is non-flammable and easy to apply.

Do not apply to new canvas - it is unnecessary and may lead to impairment of appearance.
